SACN/09/01	Iron and Health Report	The Iron report was redrafted to take into account the comments from the main meeting in February and sent to Members for signing off on 23 <sup>rd</sup> April 2010. The report was then finalised and sent for printing/publication, with the plan to publish externally in November.
SACN/10/11	Energy Requirements Report	The scientific consultation on the draft report ended on 11 February 2010 and the Working Group met on 12 April 2010 to discuss the consultation responses and amend the report. The report was then redrafted and sent to Members for comment with a deadline of 31 August 2010. These comments are being taken into consideration for publication at the end of 2010.
SACN/09/15	Report to the Chief Medical Officer (CMO) on folic acid and colorectal cancer risk	Report was sent to the CMO in October 2009. Awaiting decision by Health Ministers on mandatory folic acid fortification. A summary of the report is on the SACN website. The full report will be published on the website once the results from the meta-analysis provided by Professor Robert Clarke have been published.
SACN/10/13	Draft Early Life Nutrition and Later Health Report	Draft report was released for a 12-week scientific consultation on 8 February 2010 which ended on 30 April 2010. The Subgroup met on 5 May 2010 to discuss the consultation responses and a copy of the report came to the SACN meeting in June 2010 to discuss the proposed changes. The report was redrafted to take these discussions into consideration and a revised draft was presented to the Subgroup in September 2010. It is anticipated that the final report will be published at the end of 2010.
	Selenium report	The SACN Secretariat will do further work on this report once the iron report is published.
	NDNS	The Chair suggested that an update on NDNS including an introduction to the NDNS should be given at the October meeting. This has been delayed due to the transfer of Nutrition Policy to the Department of Health.
